Some conditions that have responded well to Bowen Therapy are

- Muscle injury
- Muscle and nerve degeneration
- Stiff joints
- Hormonal problems
- Kidney and liver problems

- General muscle tightness anywhere on the body
- Behavioural problems (due to the release of tension in the body)
- Incontinence
- Persistent limping
- Joint looseness
- Patella luxation
- Out of symmetry issues

The amount of treatment required depends on the severity of the condition and how long the animal has had the condition bur substantial relief is usually obtained after the first treatment and all but the most severe conditions are usually resolved in 2 to 5 treatments. Ongoing treatment may be required in cases of severe arthritis or other degenerative conditions.
